



## John "Jack" Lennon

March 25, 2014

Mr. John J. "Jack" Lennon, 67, of 10 Crandall St., Adams, died on Tuesday, March 25, 2014, at North Adams Commons.

Jack was born in Adams on July 25, 1946, a son of the late David and Margaret (Moriarty) Lennon. He attended Adams schools.

As a young man, Jack worked for the Rowley Fuel Co., Adams and the Town of Adams Parks Department. In 1971 he was hired as one of the first Campus Police officers for the former North Adams State College, now Massachusetts College of Liberal Arts, where he retired in 2002 with 30 years of service.

He was a communicant of the Parish of Blessed John Paul, Adams. Jack was well known throughout the Town of Adams having served on several various boards including the Cemetery Commission, the Adams Democratic Committee and the Memorial Day Parade Committee. He was a former Town Meeting Member and Constable. He, along with his friend Anthony McBride were instrumental in the placing of the American Flags in the towns business districts. He was a member of the Adams Lodge of Elks. Jack was elected to the Alert Hose Company on February 4, 1969 and remained an active member until December 4, 1984, becoming an honorary member.

The funeral will be on Saturday, March 29, at 8:00AM from the PACIOREK FUNERAL HOME, 13 Hoosac St., Adams, followed by a Liturgy of Christian Burial at 9:00AM in St. Stanislaus Kostka Church, Adams, celebrated by Rev. John Gawienowski.

Burial will follow in Bellevue Cemetery, Adams.
