Mr. John Galvin Main, Sr., 79, of 87 Windsor Pond Rd. Windsor, a former Adams resident, died Friday afternoon at Berkshire Medical Center in Pittsfield.

He was born in Norwalk, Connecticut on March 23, 1927, a son of the late Clifford C. and Elizabeth L. (Murphy) Main, and attended Norwalk schools. He moved to Adams in 1971, and had summered and lived in Windsor since that time.

Mr. Main was a Veteran of both World War II and the Korean Conflict, serving with the US Navy.

Following his Honorable Discharge, he worked first as a plumber in Norwalk. After arriving in Adams, he worked for several years for R.I. Baker Plumbing in Clarksburg. In 1974, he became a rural letter carrier for the US Postal Service, based at the Richmond Post Office, until retiring in 1993.

While in Adams, he was a communicant of the Parish of Notre Dame & St. Thomas Aquinas. He was an avid stamp collector, and had wintered for many years in Venice, Florida.

His wife, the former Jeanne J. Evon, whom he married on December 1, 1951, died on December 28, 1995.

He is survived by 3 sons - Peter J. Main of Pittsfield, MA; John G. Main. Jr. of Windsor, and D. Michael Main of Titusville, Florida;

2 Sisters - Jean Valenti of Tennessee, and Alice Lundelius of Connecticut;
