



## Mr. John R. Rogers

July 5, 1923 - May 8, 2017

Mr. John R. Rogers, 93, of Florida, MA died on Monday, May 8, 2017 at his home.

He was born in New Madrid, Missouri on July 5, 1923, a son of the late Arther and Clara (Bisher) Rogers. He attended schools in Missouri.

Mr. Rogers was a Veteran of World War II having served with the United States Navy in Normandy and was Honorably Discharged on February 22, 1946.

He was a member of the Florida Baptist Church.

His wife, the former Ruth E. Gifford, whom he married on April 6, 1946, died on May 19, 2006.
