



## John Sebastino

Mr. John Michael Sebastino, 74, of 20 Brown St. Adams, died Thursday morning at Berkshire Medical Center in Pittsfield.

He was born in North Adams on January 29, 1930, a son of the late Frank Sebastino and Margaret (Critelli) Sebastino Cimini. He attended North Adams schools, and had lived in Adams for the past 50 years.

Mr. Sebastino worked at the former Waverly Fabrics division of F. Schumacher & Co. in Adams for 30 years, until retiring when the mill closed in 1991.
