



John O. Tomasini

Mr. John Onorindo Tomasini, 71, of 13 Navajo Drive, North Adams, a former longtime resident of Adams, died early Tuesday morning, December 21, 2010, at Berkshire Medical Center in Pittsfield.

He was born in North Adams on October 10, 1939, a son of Sarah (Vicari) Tomasini and the late John Tomasini. He moved to Adams as a child, and attended Adams schools, including the former Adams High School.

Mr. Tomasini worked at General Electric Co., and , later, for Lockheed - Martin Corp. in Pittsfield for 27 years, until retiring in 1994.
