Mr. Joseph Leon Belch, Jr., 92 of 12 Daniels Court, Adams, died on Saturday, June 04, 2016, at Berkshire Medical Center in Pittsfield.

He was born in Adams on June 21, 1923, son of the late Joseph and Frances (Ramocki) Belch. He attended schools in Adams and graduated from the former Adams High School with the class of 1941. He later graduated from the General Electric Apprentice Program.

Mr. Belch was a Veteran of World War II having served with the United States Navy Air Corps until receiving his Honorable Discharge on May 20, 1946.

Mr. Belch worked as a foreman in the Power Transformer Division of the former General Electric Co., Pittsfield, for 44 years until retiring.

He was a communicant of the Parish of St. John Paul II at St. Stanislaus Kostka Church, Adams. He was a member of the Adams Post 160 American Legion, the PNA in Adams, the former St. Stanislaus Kostka Society, Adams, and the Forest Park and Wahconah Country Clubs. He had also been a Boy Scout troop leader and a member of the National Ski Patrol for several years.
