



Joseph Cyrulik

February 2, 1915 - December 3, 2005

Joseph F. Cyrulik, 90, of 22 Meadow Street, Adams, died early Saturday morning at North Adams Commons.

He was born in Adams on February 2, 1915, a son of the late Simon and Katherine (Walczak) Cyrulik. He attended schools in Adams, and moved to Poland with his family at the age of 15, returning to Adams at the age of 21.

Mr. Cyrulik worked as a finish tender at the former Arnold Print Works in Adams for 30 years, until retiring 35 years ago.

He was a communicant of St. Stanislaus Kostka Church, Adams, and was a member of the St. Stanislaus Kostka Society.

He is survived by his wife of 67 years, the former Monica E. Kruzel, whom he married on October 15, 1938;
