Mr. Joseph Daigneault, 87, of 134 Commercial St., Adams, went to be with the Lord on Friday, August 16, 2013, at the North Adams Regional Hospital.

He was born in North Adams on September 26, 1925, a son of the late Josephat and Caroline (Scott) Daigneault. He attended schools in Adams.

Mr. Daigneault was a Veteran of World War II having served with the United States Marine Corps from 1942 until receiving his Honorably Discharge in 1946.

Mr. Daigneault worked as a machinist for many years, retiring from General Electric Co., Pittsfield in 1987. Earlier he had worked for the former Arnold Print Works and Berkshire Mills.
