Mr. Joseph E. Hoczela, 62, of New Fairfield, CT, formerly of Adams, joined his parents Theodore “Joe” and Kathleen (Caffrey) Hoczela in eternity on Wednesday, June 30, 2021, after leaving this world unexpectedly at his home. He was born in Adams on August 4, 1958. He attended St. Stanislaus Kostka Elementary School. While there, and when old enough, Joe served as an alter server at St. Stanislaus Kostka Church. As a youth he participated in all sports, baseball, football and basketball. He went on to graduate from Hoosac Valley High School with the class of 1976. He then went on to graduate from the East Coast Aero Technical School and went to work for the former Eastern Airlines and retired in October 2020 from American Airlines in LaGuardia Airport in New York City as a crew chief mechanic.

Joe enjoyed repairing and figuring out how anything worked. He also enjoyed fishing and completing the daily New York Times Crossword Puzzle.
