



Joseph E. Mendonca, Jr.

February 9, 1945 - May 16, 2012

Mr. Joseph Edmund Mendonca, Jr., 67, of 102 Devonshire Dr., Cheshire, died on Wednesday, May 16, 2012 at Berkshire Medical Center, Pittsfield.

He was born in Holden, MA on February 9, 1945, the son of the late Joseph and Virginia (Ferraro) Mendonca.

Mr. Mendonca was a Veteran of the United States Navy, having served during the Vietnam War.

Mr. Mendonca worked as a carpenter his whole life, retiring as a carpenter for the City of Pittsfield in 2004. Earlier he had worked for several years in the Carpenters Union in Pittsfield. He had also worked as the building inspector for the towns of Peru and Cheshire until retiring in 2011.

He was a communicant of St. Mary of the Assumption Church, Cheshire. He was a member of the ITAM Lodge in Pittsfield, had been a volunteer firefighter for the Hoosac Hose Company, Cheshire for 18 years and had also been the president of the Cheshire Little League and the Hoosac Valley High School Football Booster Club. He enjoyed cooking and spending time with his family. He is survived by his wife of 38 years, the former Maria T. Burzimat, whom he married on April 5, 1974;
