Mr. Joseph P. Rysz, Jr., 76. of Adams and recently of Pittsfield, died Sunday evening, January 30, 2022. He was born in Adams on September 26, 1945, son of the late Joseph P. and Frances D. (Bigda) Rysz. He attended St. Stanislaus Elementary School, the St. Joseph's High School, North Adams, and graduated from the former Adams Memorial High School with the Class of 1963. He received his Bachelor's degree from the former North Adams State College. Joe was a Veteran of the Vietnam War, serving with the US Army from 1968 until his Honorable Discharge in 1970.
