



Mr. Joseph F. Wojeick

August 14, 1923 - November 25, 2018

Mr. Joseph F. Wojeick, 95, formerly of Adams, died Sunday morning, November 25, 2018, at Craneville Place in Dalton.

He was born in Adams on August 14, 1923, the son of Joseph and Blanche (Zarek) Wojeick, and attended Adams schools.

He served with the US Army from 1948 to 1950.

Mr Wojeick last worked at the former W.R. Grace Corp. in Adams for over 30 years, until retiring in 1988.
