



## Mrs. Josephine Granger

January 3, 1924 - August 16, 2016

Mrs. Josephine Anne (Dudek) Granger, 92, of Adams, died early Tuesday morning, August 16, 2016 at Williamstown Commons.

She was born in Adams on January 3, 1924, a daughter of the late Peter J. and Stefania C. (Wojnarowska) Dudek. She graduated from St. Stanislaus Elementary School in 1938, and from the former Adams High School with the Class of 1942.

Mrs. Granger was a secretary for the Adams-Cheshire Regional School District, working first at the former Adams High School, and later at Hoosac Valley High School, for 27 years until retiring. Earlier, she had worked as a secretary at the former South Adams Savings Bank.
