



Mrs. Josephine N. Rodowicz

March 6, 1922 - December 9, 2014

Mrs. Josephine N. (Wilk) Rodowicz, 92, of 23 Harding Ave. Adams, died Tuesday afternoon, December 9, 2014, at Berkshire Medical Center in Pittsfield.

She was born in Adams on March 6, 1922, a daughter of the late Joseph and Aniela (Gorzelany) Wilk. She attended Adams schools, and graduated from the former Adams High School.

Mrs. Rodowicz worked as an office clerk in the Power Transformer division of General Electric Co. in Pittsfield, until retiring in 1990.

She was a communicant of the Parish of St. John Paul II at St. Stanislaus Kostka Church, Adams, and was a member of the General Electric Quarter Century and Pensioner's Clubs.

She enjoyed traveling, especially to New York City; loved animals, and was a supporter of animal charities.

Her husband, Edward P. Rodowicz, whom she married on November 27, 1948, died on October 19, 2000.
