



## Josephine Zocchi

August 25, 1916 - February 6, 2012

Miss Josephine Frances Zocchi, 95, formerly of 69 Veazie St. North Adams, died Monday afternoon, Feb. 6, 2012, at Sweet Brook Care Center in Williamstown.

She was born in Lee, MA on August 25, 1916, a daughter of the late Angelo and Ernesta (Montagna) Zocchi. She came to North Adams as a child with her family, and attended North Adams schools. She graduated from Drury High School in 1934, where she played basketball, volleyball and badminton.

Josephine worked for the former Western Massachusetts Electric Co., first as a meter reader, and later as a draftsman, from 1949 until retiring in 1979. She was also a volunteer at North Adams Regional Hospital for several years. She was a communicant of the former St. Anthony of Padua Church, North Adams, and was a member and Past President of St. Anthony's Rosary Society.

She was an avid sports fan, and loved watching her beloved Boston Red Sox and Celtics.

She is survived by a brother, Louis Zocchi of North Adams;
