Miss Julia Janowski, went home to be with her Lord and Savior on Wednesday, February 17, 2021. Most recently, Julia made her home at the North Adams Commons.

One of nine children, Julia was born July 15, 1928 in Adams, the daughter of the late Thomas and Sophie (Tomkiewicz) Janowski. A 1948 graduate of the former Adams High School, she received her Registered Nurse degree in 1951 from Cooley Dickinson Hospital.
