



## Julia Truskowski

Mrs. Julia R. (Czubryt) Truskowski, 79, of 6 Meadow Lane, Adams, died Thursday morning at her home.

She was born in Adams on April 30, 1925, a daughter of the late John and Mary (Kotry) Czubryt, and attended Adams schools.

Mrs. Truskowski owned and operated the former Julie's Variety Store on Summer Street in Adams for several years, until retiring in 1977.
