



## Mrs. June D. McLain

July 4, 1927 - January 11, 2016

Mrs. June Dorothy (England) McLain, 88, of Proprietor's Field, 118 Church St. Williamstown, died early Monday morning, January 11, 2016, at Williamstown Commons.

She was born in North Adams on July 4, 1927, a daughter of the late Ralph England and Emma (Birch) Wilson England, and attended North Adams schools.

Mrs. McLain last worked at the Burger King restaurant in North Adams, until retiring. Earlier, she worked as a snack bar attendant at the Mt. Greylock Bowl in North Adams, and the former Green Mountain Race Track in Pownal, VT. She also was an activities assistant at Proprietor's Field for several years. She enjoyed socializing, dining at the former Friendly's in North Adams, and playing the lottery.

Her first husband, Roland Burke, was killed in action during the Korean War, shortly after they were married. Her husband, Stewart A. McLain, whom she married on April 25, 1954, died on October 27, 1989.

She is survived by two sons, Wayne McLain and his wife, Diane; and James McLain, both of North Adams;

She was predeceased by a son, Stephen McLain, who died in infancy; 2 brothers, Arthur Wilson and Ralph England, Jr., and by 2 sisters, Lillian Thomas and Hilda LeBlond.

Funeral services will be held on Thursday, January 14th, at 10:00 AM in the PACIOREK FUNERAL HOME, 13 Hoosac St. Adams.
