



## Mrs. Katherine E. Reeves

April 21, 1934 - July 1, 2023

Mrs. Katherine E. (MacMullen) Reeves, 89, of Savoy, died on Saturday, July 1, 2023 at Hillcrest Commons in Pittsfield.

She was born in South Boston on April 21, 1934, a daughter of the late Albert and Jessie “Nettie” (Harrow) MacMullen. She attended schools in Boston and New Hampshire and graduated from Portsmouth High School.
