



Kenneth G. Stewart

December 13, 1916 - June 30, 2010

Mr. Kenneth George Stewart, 93, of 25 Adams Road, Williamstown, a former longtime resident of 178 East Road, Adams, died on Wednesday, June 30, 2010, at Williamstown Commons.

He was born in North Adams on December 13, 1916, son of the late George and Ruth (Mason) Stewart. He attended schools in Dalton, and graduated from the former Dalton High School with the class of 1934.

Mr. Stewart was a veteran of World War II, having served with the Merchant Marines.

Mr. Stewart last worked for the former Adams Supermarkets in Adams and North Adams. Earlier he had worked for Fred Crane in Dalton, Burnett's Farm, Adams, and in his younger years he had done boiler repairs.

He was a longtime member of the First Congregational Church, Adams. He was a member of the Cheshire Senior Citizens.

His wife, the former Pearl V. Chamberlain whom he married on February 14, 1940, died on November 29, 2008. They had celebrated 68 years of marriage.
