



Larry G. Rancourt

March 3, 1942 - March 9, 2010

Mr. Larry George Rancourt, 68, of 27 Robbins St. Hinsdale, New Hampshire, a native and former resident of Adams, died Tuesday morning, March 9, 2010, at Brattleboro (VT) Memorial Hospital.

He was born in Adams on March 3, 1942, son of the late George and Arleigh (Sime) Rancourt. He attended Adams schools, and graduated from the former Adams High School. He had lived in Adams and Readsboro, VT until moving to Hinsdale in 2007.

Mr. Rancourt worked in the maintenance department, and later, as an instructor, in the plant maintenance program at C.H. McCann Vocational-Technical High School in North Adams from 1980 until retiring in 1998. He had also owned and operated Rancourt's Carpet and Bellevue Memorials in Adams for several years.

While in Adams, he was a member of the First Congregational Church, where he had been a member of its Pilgrim Fellowship Youth Group. He enjoyed model building and woodworking, and in his younger years, had raced stock cars at Lebanon Valley Speedway.

He is survived by his wife, the former Beverley A. Juby, whom he married on December 27, 1995;

His brother-in-law, John Juby, and his wife, Marianne, of Adams; and several cousins in Texas, Virginia and Maryland.

A Graveside funeral service will be held on Saturday, March 13th, at 10:00 AM in Bellevue Cemetery, Adams. Relatives and friends are invited.
