



## Laura Winarski

March 15, 1921 - January 3, 2011

Mrs. Laura Lucy (Alibozek) Winarski, 89, of 61 East Hoosac St. Adams, died early Monday morning, January 3, 2011, at North Adams Regional Hospital. She was born in Adams on March 15, 1921, a daughter of the late Frank and Aniela (Struzik) Alibozek. She attended Adams schools.
