



## Laurie A. Tatro

April 1, 1963 - February 6, 2008

Mrs. Laurie Anne (Dubis) Tatro, 44, of 50 Greylock Ave., Adams, died on Wednesday February 6, 2008 at Berkshire Medical Center, Pittsfield, following a long courageous battle with ovarian cancer.

She was born in Pittsfield on April 1, 1963, daughter of Stanley and Cynthia (Morin) Dubis. She attended schools in Adams, and graduated from Hoosac Valley High School with the class of 1981.

Shortly after graduation, Mrs. Tatro moved to New Hampshire with her husband and worked as a graphic designer for the Kenmore Stamp Co., Milford, NH. After moving back to Adams she worked as a Data Processor for Berkshire Bank in Pittsfield until December 31, 2006 when ill health forced her to retire.
