



Mr. Lawrence R. Lauth

February 26, 1934 - September 9, 2015

Mr. Lawrence Richard Lauth, 81, of 4 Tracie Ave. Adams, died Wednesday morning, September 9, 2015, at Berkshire Medical Center in Pittsfield.

He was born in Adams on February 26, 1934, a son of the late William J. and Blanche (Serre) Lauth. He attended local schools, including the former Notre Dame School in Adams, and graduated from Drury High School in North Adams.

He was a veteran of the Korean Conflict, serving with the 40th Field Artillery Battalion of the US Army, stationed in Korea for 17 months. He was Honorably Discharged as a Specialist 3rd Class on Feb. 6, 1957, and also received the Good Conduct Medal. He then served with the US Army Reserves for several years.

Following his discharge, he started working for the former New England Lime Co. and its successor, Pfizer, Inc. in Adams for 33 ½ years, until retiring on August 1, 1992 as a maintenance repairman.

He was a communicant of St. Stanislaus Kostka Church, Adams.

He enjoyed gardening, yardwork, walking and traveling.

He is survived by his wife of 57 years, the former Dorothy Wolkowicz, whom he married on June 7, 1958 in St. Stanislaus Kostka Church, Adams;

His daughter, Debra Jozefiak and her husband, Gary, of Adams;

2 granddaughters, Sarah Jozefiak of Cary, NC; and Lori O'Dell and her husband, Kirk, of Bennington, VT;

A sister, Yvonne Arey of Vernon, CT., and several nieces, nephews,

grandnieces and grandnephews.

He was predeceased by a brother, William J. Lauth, on Feb. 3, 1972.

The funeral will be held on Saturday, Sept. 12th, at 1:00 PM from the PACIOREK FUNERAL HOME, 13 Hoosac St. Adams, followed by a Liturgy of Christian Burial at 1:30 PM in St. Stanislaus Kostka Church, celebrated by Rev. Stephen G. Montesanti, Pastor.
