



Leo D. Lecuyer

July 6, 1923 - January 10, 2013

Mr. Leo David Lecuyer, 89, of 15 Highland Ave. Adams, died early Thursday morning, January 10, 2013, at Sweet Brook Care Center in Williamstown.

He was born in Adams on July 6, 1923, a son of the late David and Anna (Bechard) Lecuyer, and attended Adams schools, including the former Notre Dame Elementary and Adams High School.

Mr. Lecuyer was a Veteran of World War II, serving with the US Navy in the Asiatic-Pacific Theater, where he saw heavy combat in the South Pacific, until his Honorable Discharge in 1945.

He last worked as a lab technician at the former Sprague Electric Co. in North Adams, until retiring after 40 years of service.

He was a communicant of the Parish of Blessed John Paul, Adams, and its predecessor, Notre Dame des Sept Douleurs Church. He was a member of Post 9566 Veterans of Foreign Wars, Dalton, and was a member and past commander of the former Burnette-Bednarz Post 1995 Veterans of Foreign Wars, Adams. He was also a member of the Adams Lodge of Elks.

His wife of 60 years, the former Cecilia T. Pevoski (Przewoznik), whom he married on May 8, 1948, died on October 6, 2008.

He is survived by a daughter, Carol A. Betti and her husband, Jeffrey, of Williamstown; A son, Gary L. Lecuyer and his wife, Christine, of Adams; A Granddaughter, Catherine Lecuyer of San Francisco, CA; A Grandson, David Lecuyer of Richmond, VA; and several nieces and nephews, grandnieces and grandnephews.

He was predeceased by a sister, M. Jeannette Krzeminski, on Feb. 27, 2011.

The funeral will be held on Monday, January 14th, at 12 Noon from the PACIOREK FUNERAL HOME, 13 Hoosac St. Adams, followed by a Liturgy of Christian Burial at 1:00 PM in the Parish Church of Blessed John Paul, Adams.

Burial will follow in Bellevue Cemetery, Adams.
