Mr. Leonard Roy Wandrei, 69, of 43 Enterprise St. Adams, died Thursday afternoon at Berkshire Medical Center in Pittsfield.

He was born in Adams on October 23, 1935, a son of the late August and Lily (Poupart) Wandrei, and attended Adams schools.

Mr. Wandrei was a US Army Veteran, serving from 1958 to 1960.
