Mr. Lester C. Dumoulin, 87, of Clarksburg, joined his beloved wife Claire in Heaven on Wednesday, March 30, 2016 surrounded by his loving family. He was born in North Adams on December 4, 1928 to Ernest J. and Julie (Poirot) Dumoulin.

Lester graduated from Drury High School with the class of 1948 alongside the love of his life and future with Claire McNine.

Lester and Claire were married on September 30, 1950 in North Adams. Lester enlisted in the United States Navy and proudly served during the Korean Conflict.

For many years Les was employed as a draftsman at the former Sprague Electric Co. He worked tirelessly to build the business to serve the community before selling the business in 1995 and retiring.
