Mrs. Lila Clarissa (Burnett) Nimmons, 89, of 77 Emerald Lane, Williamstown, died Wednesday morning at Sweet Brook Care Center in Williamstown. She was born in Pittsfield on September 5, 1916, a daughter of the late Benjamin H. and Bertha A. (Meacham) Burnett, and attended Adams schools, graduating from the former Adams High School.. She lived in Adams most of her life, until moving to Williamstown 20 years ago.

Mrs. Nimmons was a homemaker most of her life, but had worked for several years as an inspector at the former Berkshire Fine Spinning Co. in Adams.
