Mrs. Lillian May (Whalen) Demastrie, 82, of 45 Loop Road, Savoy, died Saturday afternoon, July 3, 2010, at Sweet Brook Care Center in Williamstown.

She was born in Savoy on August 6, 1927, a daughter of the late Clarence and Mildred (Hathaway) Whalen. She attended schools in Savoy, and graduated from the former Adams High School.
