



## Lillian M. Piwko

January 20, 1919 - July 2, 2006

Mrs. Lillian Monica (Gutowski) Piwko, 87, of 4 Second St. Adams, died early Sunday morning at Medway Country Manor in Medway, MA.

She was born in Adams on January 20, 1919, a daughter of the late Charles and Katherine (Lenartowicz) Gutowski, and attended Adams schools.
