Mrs. Loretta Anita (Brazeau) Morey, 93, of Adams, died Friday afternoon at Williamstown Commons.

She was born in North Adams on July 4, 1924, a daughter of the late Alfred and Angelina (Patenaude) Brazeau. She attended schools in Pittsfield, and graduated from Pittsfield High School.

Mrs. Morey was employed by General Electric Co. in Pittsfield, and later, for over 30 years at the former W.R. Grace Co. in Adams.

After retiring, she volunteered for many years in the Adams school system. She was very devoted to her immediate family and her extended family of nieces and nephews. She was very well read and worldly in her outlook and lifestyle. For many years, she enjoyed the friendship and camaraderie of her swimming group at the YMCA.

Her husband, Bernard Morey, whom she married on June 18, 1949, died on Sept. 29, 1998.
