Mrs. Lorraine Dorothy (Kuzia) Alvarez Scieszka, 72, of 45 Burt St. Adams, died Sunday afternoon, January 2, 2005, at North Adams Regional Hospital, shortly after being admitted.

She was born in Adams on February 29, 1932, daughter of the late William and Genevieve (Sieczkowski) Kuzia, and attended Adams schools.
