January 6, 1924 - November 24, 2006

Mrs. Lottie A. (Ziemba) DeCoigne, 82, of 202 North Summer St. Adams, died Friday afternoon, November 24, 2006, at her home following a long illness. She was born in Adams on January 6, 1924, a daughter of the late John and Mary (Kordana) Ziemba, and attended Adams schools.

Mrs. DeCoigne worked at General Electric Co. in Pittsfield for 15 years, until retiring in January of 1986. Earlier, she had worked at the former Berkshire Fine Spinning Co. and Gaylord Co. in Adams, and Sprague Electric Co in North Adams.
