April 7, 1936 - June 24, 2013

Mr. Louis Leo LaBonte, 77, of 105 Winter St., North Adams, died on Monday, June 24, 2013 at the North Adams Regional Hospital.

He was born in North Adams on April 7, 1936, a son of the late Leo and Mary Jane (Courtemanche) LaBonte. He attended schools in North Adams and graduated from Drury High School.

Mr. LaBonte worked for many years as a painter for various businesses in North Adams until retiring.

He was a 25 year member of the North Adams Lodge of Elks. He had enjoyed coaching North Adams Youth Football for 18 years and also enjoyed hunting with his son and spending time with his grandchildren.

He is survived by his wife of 56 years, the former Elva S. Skellie, whom he married on February 21, 1957;
