



## Mrs Lubow M. Janowycz

December 18, 1921 - February 20, 2014

Mrs. Lubow M. (Bodnar) Janowycz, 92, of Wells Road, Cheshire, died Thursday morning, February 20, 2014, at Sweet Brook Care Center in Williamstown.

She was born in the Ukraine on December 18, 1921, daughter of the late Eugene and Stefania (Nestor) Bodnar. She attended schools in the Ukraine, and came to the United States in 1951, living first in Ohio before settling in Cheshire.

Mrs. Janowycz worked as a technician in the laboratory at North Adams Regional Hospital for many years, until retiring in 1986.

She was a communicant of the former St. John the Baptist Ukrainian Catholic Church in Pittsfield. She enjoyed arts and crafts, and created ceramic items that were sold in Ukrainian specialty shops in New York City for many years. Her husband, Michael W. Janowycz, whom she married on June 16, 1948 in Kitzbuhl, Austria, died on May 22, 2005.

She is survived by her daughter, Vera H. Socha of Cheshire;
