Lynn Ann Burke, 66, of Adams, died on Thursday, March 23, 2017 at Berkshire Medical Center in Pittsfield.

She was born in Adams on May 28, 1950, daughter of the late Edward and Claire (Kelly) Burke. Her parents died at a young age and she was raised by her grandparents. She attended schools in Adams and graduated from the former Adams Memorial High School with the class of 1968. She went on to earn her Licensed Practical Nurse degree from the Charles H.
