Mrs. M. Norma (Fortier) Klein, 92, of Adams, died Sunday evening, September 11, 2022 at Mount Carmel Care Center in Lenox. She was born in Adams on March 13, 1930, a daughter of the late John E. and Amy (Frese) Fortier. She graduated from the former Adams High School with the Class of 1948. When she wasn't working in her yard she enjoyed quilting, home decorating and walking.
