



Ms. Marcia J. Payette

May 13, 1944 - December 11, 2016

Ms. Marcia Jane (Pontier) Payette, 72, of Adams, died on Sunday, December 11, 2016 at Berkshire Medical Center in Pittsfield after a brief illness.

She was born in North Adams on May 13, 1944, a daughter of the late Joseph and Philia (Kwasnicke) Pontier. She attended schools in North Adams and graduated from Drury High School with the class of 1962.

Ms. Payette was a well-known seamstress having owned and operated her own business for the past 25 years, The Drapery Factory in Pittsfield. She had also worked for many years at Waverly Fabrics in Adams.
