February 4, 1921 - March 14, 2011

Mrs. Margaret "Irish" (Haggerty) Anthony, 90, of 13 West Road, Adams, died on Monday, March 14, 2011, at her home surrounded by her family.

She was born in Adams on February 4, 1921, daughter of the late Thomas F. Haggerty, Sr. and Mary (Montville) Haggerty. She attended schools in Adams and graduated from the former Adams High School with the class of 1939.
