



Mrs. Margaret P. Paradise

July 26, 1930 - October 19, 2015

Mrs. Margaret P. (Williams) Paradise, 85, of 3 Myrtle St. Adams, died Monday afternoon, October 19, 2015, at Baystate Medical Center in Springfield.

She was born in North Adams on July 26, 1930, a daughter of the late Frank and Margaret (Clark) Williams. She attended North Adams schools, and graduated from Drury High School. She had lived in Cheshire for several years, until moving to Adams several years ago.

Mrs. Paradise worked at the former Cornish Wire Corp. in Williamstown for many years, until retiring.

She attended St. Mary of the Assumption Church, Cheshire, and was a member of Dr. George L. Curran Post 996 Veterans of Foreign Wars Ladies Auxiliary, North Adams. She enjoyed playing Bingo and taking trips to the casinos.
