



Mrs. Margaret M. Wing

May 10, 1923 - February 17, 2016

Mrs. Margaret M. (Conlon) Wing, 92, of 10 Woods Drive, Adams, died Wednesday evening, February 17, 2016, at Williamstown Commons following a long illness.

She was born in North Adams on May 10, 1923, daughter of the late Mary (Caron) Conlon and Michael W. Conlon, former North Adams Chief of Police. Peg, as she liked to be called, graduated from the former St. Joseph's High School with the Class of 1940. She attended Bliss Business College before entering St. Luke's School of Nursing, where she earned her RN.

Peg was a Veteran of World War II, serving with the US Navy in Chelsea, MA and Mare Island, CA where she earned the rank of Ensign before being Honorably Discharged in 1946.

In civilian life, Peg worked as an RN at the former W.B. Plunkett Hospital in Adams, where she met the love of her life, Joe Wing. They were married on May 14, 1949, and celebrated 59 anniversaries together before Joe passed on October 9, 2008.

Peg was a communicant of St. John Paul II Parish, Adams. She was a member of Adams Post 160 American Legion. She was a longtime Bingo player, an avid reader, and was known for her knitting expertise, creating over the years beautiful afghans, sweaters, slippers, and Christmas stockings that she donated to her daughter's school classes.

Peg is survived by her daughter, Karen W. Koehler, and her husband, James, of Adams; a grandson, Michael J. Koehler and his husband, Joseph St. St.

Hilaire, of Adams;

a brother, Michael W. Conlon and his wife, Marion (Bishop) Conlon of Cheshire; and several nieces and nephews.

The funeral for Margaret Wing will be held on Thursday, February 25th, at 10:00 AM from the PACIOREK FUNERAL HOME, 13 Hoosac St. Adams, followed by a Liturgy of Christian Burial at 11:00 AM in Notre Dame des Sept Douleurs Church, Adams, celebrated by Rev. Steven Montesanti, Pastor. Burial will be in the spring in Bellevue Cemetery, Adams.

Calling hours are Wednesday from 4 to 7 PM at the funeral home.
