Mr. Marian Dzbenski, 74, of 17 Wall St. North Adams, died Tuesday evening at North Adams Regional Hospital.

He was born in Siemien, Poland on October 28, 1930, son of the late John and Mariana Dzbenski. He attended schools in Poland. He immigrated to this country 40 years ago to build a better life for his wife and children, leaving behind a life he was accustomed to.
