



## Mrs. Marie C. Greenbush

December 2, 1940 - October 28, 2021

Mrs. Marie Colomba (Picciuto) Greenbush, 80, of Adams, died Thursday morning, October 28, 2021, at her home, surrounded by her family. She was born in Brockton, MA on December 2, 1940, a daughter of the late John and Mary (Uva) Picciuto. She graduated from Avon High School, and later graduated from the Brockton School of Beauty Culture.
