



## Marilyn Randall

Mrs. Marilyn Dorothy (Tosi) Randall, 76, of 75 Walling Road, Adams, died on Tuesday, September 8, 2015 at her home, surrounded by her family.

She was born in Somerville, MA on June 19, 1939, daughter of the late Laurence and Mary (Albertini) Tosi. She attended schools in Somerville. Mrs. Randall graduated from the Boston State Teachers College having earned her Master's Degree in Education. She then went on to earn her Master's Degree in Reading from Boston State College.

Mrs. Randall first taught 1st and 2nd grade for the Conwell School in Somerville until she moved to Adams where she started teaching for the Adams-Cheshire Regional School District. While teaching in Adams she became the coordinator for the Title 1 program and then became the Director of the program until her retirement.

She was a communicant of St. Mary of the Assumption Church, Cheshire. She was a member of the Catholic Daughters of the Americas and a former member of the St. Thomas Aquinas Rosary Society. She was a professed member of Our Lady of Carmelite, North Adams, a book club member at the Adams Free Library and a longtime member, board director and treasurer of the Adams Agricultural Fair.

She is survived by her husband of 47 years, Douglas E. Randall, whom she married on June 29, 1968;
