August 15, 1926 - August 31, 2009

Mrs. Marion A. (McCulloch) Lyden, 83, of 91 Friend St., Adams, died on Monday, August 31, 2009, at Berkshire Medical Center, Pittsfield.

She was born in Adams on August 15, 1926, the daughter of the late Elmer and Hallie (Farren) McCulloch. She attended schools in Adams and graduated from the former Adams High School with the class of 1944. Mrs. Lyden then went on to graduate from the former Henry W. Bishop Memorial School of Nursing in 1947 as a Registered Nurse.

Mrs. Lyden worked as a Registered Nurse for the Adams Cheshire Regional School District until her retirement. Earlier she had taught for the Charles H. McCann LPN Program, North Adams, and had worked for the former Plunkett Hospital, Adams.
