Mrs. Marjorie J. (Hathaway) Bellman, 82, of 61 Notch Rd. Adams, died early Tuesday morning, April 10, 2012, at North Adams Regional Hospital.

She was born in Adams on March 30, 1930, daughter of the late Arthur H. and Olive E. (Jenks) Hathaway. She graduated from the former Adams High School, and attended the former North Adams State College.
