



Mrs. Marlene J. Hayden

August 12, 1933 - January 3, 2022

Mrs. Marlene Joyce (Vokey) Hayden, 88, of Adams, died on Monday, January 3, 2022, at her home.

She was born in Adams on August 12, 1933, daughter of the late Nathaniel and Mildred (Zoltek) Vokey. She attended schools in Adams and graduated from the former Adams High School.

Mrs. Hayden last worked for the former Filenes Department Store in the Berkshire Mall before retiring. Earlier she had worked for the former Schiff Clothing Store in Adams and in the cafeteria for the Adams Cheshire Regional School District.

She was a communicant of the Parish of St. John Paul II, Adams, and the former St. Thomas Aquinas Church, where she taught CCD. She had also been a volunteer at Plunkett Elementary School and a Hospice volunteer. Her husband, Ronald M. Hayden, whom she married on October 9, 1954, died on February 28, 1994.
