January 20, 1958 - March 18, 2025

It is with our deepest sorrow that we announce the untimely passing of our Martin Carl Cristofolini. He died on Tuesday, March 18, 2025, at Albany Medical Center from renal failure complications.

He was born on January 20, 1958 as the middle child of Margie (Tower) Cristofolini of Readsboro, VT and the late Aldo Cristofolini. He leaves behind two brothers, Michael Cristofolini of North Adams and James Cristofolini of Indiana.
