Mrs. Mary Anne B. (Gamache) Carter, 94, of North Adams, died Monday evening, September 8, 2025 at Williamstown Commons. She was born in Albany, NY on April 21, 1931, the daughter of the late Ernest A. and Mary A. (Modena) Gamache.
