



## Mary Ann Cardonnel

Mrs. Mary Ann (Baran) Cardonnel, 98, of 1 North Summer St. Adams, died Monday afternoon, October 18, 2010, at Sweet Brook Care Center in Williamstown.

She was born in Adams on September 8, 1912, the daughter of the late John and Aniela (Frodyma) Baran, and attended Adams schools, including St. Stanislaus Kostka Elementary School.

Mrs. Cardonnel worked as a telephone operator for the former New England Telephone Co. for 20 years, until retiring in 1977. Earlier, she was employed by the former Berkshire Fine Spinning Co. in Adams for 25 years.

She had been a communicant of St. Stanislaus Kostka Church, Adams, and was a member of the Telephone Pioneers of America.

Her husband, Joseph O. Cardonnel, whom she married on August 5, 1939, died on August 29, 1996.

She is survived by her nephews, John Baran, Joseph Baran, Jerome Baran, Dr. Daniel Baran and Stanley Baran, Jr. and their families. She was predeceased by her 2 brothers, Stanley and James Baran.

The funeral will be held on Thursday, October 21st, at 9:30 AM from the PACIOREK FUNERAL HOME, 13 Hoosac St. Adams, followed by a Liturgy of Christian Burial at 10:00 AM in the Parish Church of Pope John Paul the Great, Adams, celebrated by Rev. Daniel J. Boyle, Pastor.
